Remembrance Sunday Risk Assessment – 8 November 2020**

<b>What are the Hazards</b>	<b>Who might be harmed?</b>	<b>Controls required</b>	<b>Additional controls</b>
<p>Spread of Coronavirus</p>	<p>Those invited to attend (including members of the armed forces and veterans) those laying wreaths at the War Memorial, residents and anyone else visiting the village on 8/11/20, vulnerable groups, elderly, pregnant women, those with underlying health conditions.</p>	<p>Social distancing by maintaining 2 metre gap between individuals (unless they are in the same household or are part of an individual's support bubble or are standing with just one other person from outside their household) as recommended by the Public Health Authority</p> <p>Masks are to be worn in compliance with Public Health Guidance</p> <p>Symptoms of Coronavirus – anyone concerned that they are unwell should not attend the service at the War Memorial, nor should those who are isolating as close contacts of a case or who have been advised to do so by Test and Trace and those quarantining.</p> <p>Those in vulnerable groups should place themselves away from the main body of attendees by the War Memorial.</p> <p>Anyone who becomes unwell in the days following the Act of Remembrance with a new continuous cough or high temperature should follow the Government stay at home guidance and contact the Public health Authority to discuss the case and identify people who have been in close contact with them taking advice on action to be taken.</p> <p>Wreath bearers will have a wreath allocated to them and will be asked to sanitise their hands before and after picking up their wreath.</p> <p>To facilitate Test and Trace contact details of all those invited to participate will be recorded and retained for 21 days.</p>	<p>Marshals at the War Memorial will encourage attendees to maintain a 2 metre distance and to wear a face mask both when observing the commemoration and when leaving the area to return home.</p> <p>Large signs will be positioned near the War Memorial to remind attendees to maintain a social distance.</p> <p>Marshals will also advise those in vulnerable groups to place themselves away from the main body.</p>
